The **Open** section will be ECF graded and is open to all.

The **Minor** section will be ungraded and is for inexperienced players or players graded below ECF 40. It's ideally suited to those new to competitive tournament chess. Instruction will be given in how to use a chess clock to those new to it.

Time Control: 25 mins plus 5 sec increment per move

Please note that players play in every round, Swiss pairings will be used. This is not a knockout tournament.

Children must be accompanied by an appropriate adult for the duration of the day.

Prizes

Open : There will be open awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Best Girl and county titles for the best Leicestershire & Rutland qualified player in the U18, U13, U11, U9 age groups (age at 31/8/16)

Minor : There will be awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Best Girl and for the best Leicestershire & Rutland qualified player in the U11 and U9s.

Under 9 : School years 1- 4

Under 11 : School years 5 & 6

Under 13 : School years 7 & 8

Under 18 : School years 9 - 13

More awards may be added based on entries received.

Leicestershire & Rutland qualification is either by county of birth, county of residence or by attendance at a school in Leicestershire or Rutland.
